### STREETLIGHTS: (Updated)

- (NEW) Rec'd quote from Sargent's Electric. Currently comparing quotes – decision soon.
- All streetlights inspected by FT.
- Globe holding screws removed and holes retapped.
- New stainless screws to be installed in the next few weeks.
- Quote for all new streetlight top fixtures received. Under review

### FENCE (Vinyl & Chain Link): (Updated)

- (NEW) Chain link debris cleared so repair can begin.
- (NEW) Rebuilding may start next week or early the following week.
- Formal vinyl fence restoration quote received and approved by BOD.
- Start date early February could be a little earlier.
- Chain link debris clearing at repair areas in mid January.

### IRRIGATION: (AL - - PLEASE UPDATE THIS AREA)

This past week, the following was accomplished:

- Leaks at base of oak tree #224 and #326 located. Both require rerun of piping.
- Small repairs made on clock #3 homes.
- Break at #201 valve scheduled repair next week
- First of 2 new irrigation pumps received. Second one expected 3rd week of January.
- Preliminary station work will begin early January (Finally!).

### DEBRIS (Updated)

- (New) Pine tree stump in West Lakeside FINALLY DONE!
